## WATER RESOURCES LENDING LIBRARY FOR EDUCATORS

The City of Bend’s Utility Department offers a variety of free resources, including many kid-friendly hands-on models, informational guides, and website links. 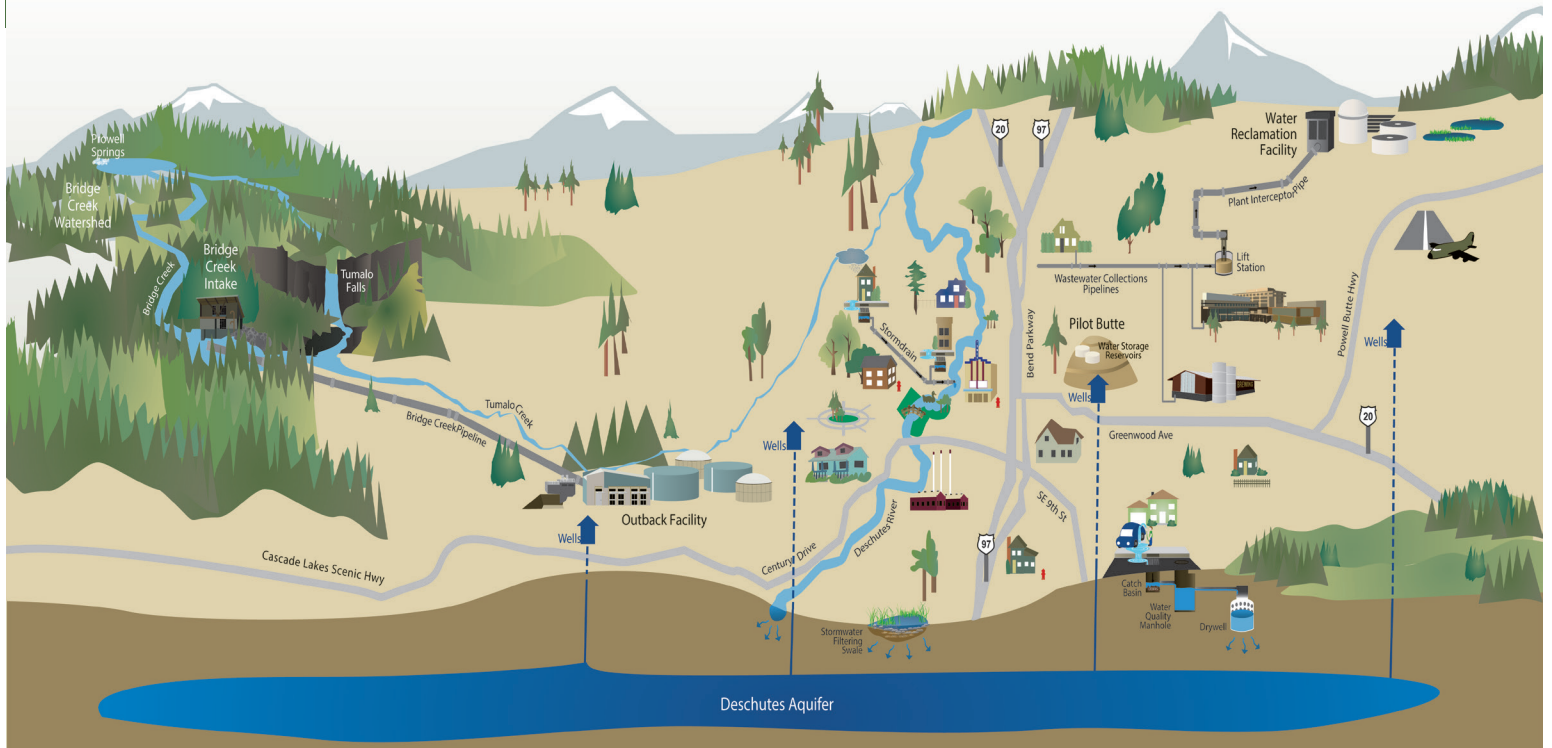
### STORMWATER

- **Tabletop Watershed Diorama** – Hands-on teaching tool for how water moves through a watershed; can be used to explore stormwater and groundwater pollution and pollution prevention techniques.
- **Full-Size Underground Injection Control Model** – Working model of how stormwater is injected underground towards groundwater supplies.
