










## FY 2023/24 Actual vs. Expected Event Attendance

### Regionwide Pending Projects: Q4 FY 2023/24









### Bend Pending Projects: Q4 FY 2023/24










# Bend Pending Projects by Industry


- Scientific (mainly bioscience) represents 8% of total projects, but 70% of anticipated new jobs, representing a potential 393 new positions in Bend, the majority of which are from existing local businesses or "Grow" projects.
- High Technology accounts for 39% of total pending projects and 81 anticipated new jobs. Over 50% of these new jobs are businesses considering relocating to Bend..








### "Move" Done Deals: FY 2023/24












Measure 118 FACTS

Measure 118 would add a 3% gross receipts tax on businesses with annual Oregon sales over \$25 million.

The tax could impact various sectors including grocery stores, utilities, auto dealers, and healthcare providers.

Oregon's Legislative Revenue Office estimates Measure 118 will reduce the general fund by nearly \$4 billion in its first two years

The Tax Foundation expects Oregon to be among the "10 Worst Business Tax Climates" if Measure 118 passes.
