City of Bend Sponsorship Program Report

Fiscal Year 2023-24











Overview:

The City of Bend sponsorship program for the fiscal year 2023-24 reflects a commitment to fostering community engagement, promoting inclusivity, and supporting events that enrich the cultural and social fabric of the city. The diverse range of events and programs supported throughout the year reflects the program's commitment to equity fund distribution, transparency in the process, and responsible fund allocation.



Key Tenants:

Equitable and Accessible Funding: Funds are provided to community partners to ensure accessibility and fairness, enabling a broad spectrum of organizations to benefit from City support.

Transparent Application and Vetting Process: The sponsorship program application and vetting processes ensure that decisions regarding fund allocation are transparent and accountable by maintaining transparency.

Responsible Fund Distribution: City discretionary funds are distributed in a manner that prevents the creation of reliance on City funds by community organizations, allowing them to host events and programs without developing an expectation of continued City support.

Transparent Application and Vetting Process: The sponsorship program maintains transparency through its application and vetting processes, ensuring that decisions regarding fund allocation are transparent and accountable.

Program Improvements:

The Sponsorship Committee, composed of programmatic and department leaders, initiated an internal project to measure and monitor the impact of City sponsorships in building a stronger, more inclusive, and equitable community. This process improvement journey also included a related short-term sponsorship policy update project. In response to Council's request, our staff updated the sponsorship policy to ensure that funded community partners organized programming aligned with City goals and where everyone felt welcome.

The internal program improvement project had three key objectives that were all successfully addressed, and their impact will allow the program to do the following:


- 1. Establish consistent and coordinated processes for community partners to access City sponsorship funding. We ensured that all organizations, regardless of size or resources, could access these funds to support their valuable work in our city.
- 2. **Emphasize a one-city approach to sponsorship awards.** We brought all City departments into the project to provide visibility, insight, and feedback to ensure departments are involved in the updated process and have the resources to guide community partners to the Sponsorship program. A Sponsorship Committee was established to ensure that representation from all city departments is available during the review of sponsorship requests.

3. **Implement a tracking system to showcase our contributions.** We can now effectively demonstrate how we supported community events, initiatives, and programs, where City funds were allocated, and how these resources benefited our community as a whole

Highlights of Sponsored Events and Programs:

- 1. Community Leadership and Workforce Development:
 Programs such as Bend NEXT, Leadership Bend, Pitch Latino,
 Bend Economic Development Advisory Board (BEDAB)
 sponsorships, City Club, and the Young Professionals Summit
 primarily target young professionals, emerging leaders, and
 individuals interested in workforce housing initiatives. Total
 amount contributed: \$29,000.
- Cultural and Diversity Celebrations: Events like Welcoming Week, Central Oregon Pride, Juneteenth, Día de los Muertos, Lunar New Year Celebration, Asian American and Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander Heritage Month, celebrating and embracing diverse cultural groups. Total amount contributed: \$39,255.
- 3. **Environmental Initiatives:** Sponsored events like the Earth Day Fair, The Environmental Center Climate Solutions programs,

Forest Restoration, Deschutes River Cleanup, Go Clean Energy Conference, Community Garden



- 4. **Social Services and Support:** Programs such as the Food Recovery Program, Food Pantry, LGBTQ+ Youth Affinity Crew, and others serve vulnerable populations including low-income families, LGBTQ+ youth, and individuals experiencing food insecurity. **Total amount contributed:** \$17,500.
- 5. **General Community Engagement and Events:** Various community engagement events, fundraisers, and social gatherings contribute to the overall well-being and community cohesion. **Total amount contributed:** \$29,843.
