MPO Boundary Update – Tumalo Outreach	Background After each decennial census, the Census Bureau adjusts the Urbanized Area Boundary (UZA) and Federal Aid Urban Boundary (FAUB) for every City to reflect population growth and land use changes. State DOTs then work with cities to adjust the FAUB to incorporate local conditions. The MPO boundary must include all areas identified within the FAUB. The Tumalo area in the existing MPO boundary is no longer required. Prior to making any changes to the boundary at Tumalo, the MPO Policy Board requested public input. Staff will review results of outreach efforts to Tumalo residents and next steps of the boundary update process.
