

People experiencing houselessness: 959


Shortage: 436 beds short

### The Lighthouse Navigation Center - Renovation



- 100 walk up beds and daytime services hub
- Started in late September 2023
  - Replacing Roof
    HVAC
    Flooring/lighting
- Adding
  - $\circ$  Commercial kitchen
  - $\circ \, \text{Laundry}$
  - $\circ$  Multi-user bathrooms
  - $\circ$  Showers



## **Council Actions**

#### Franklin Avenue Shelter:

- Acceptance of COIC 5511 Award
   Total award: \$1,455,555
- Lease Agreement
  - $\circ$  No cost
- Contract Amendment
  - Increase NTE to \$2,304,994
  - Extend contract dates through June 30, 2025





## **Council Actions**

#### Lighthouse Navigation Center:

- Lease Agreement
  - $\circ$  \$5,050 per month
- Contract Amendment
  - $\odot$  Increase NTE to \$5,251,487
  - $\odot~$  Extend contract end date to 12/31/2026

#### **Stepping Stone:**

- Lease Agreement
  - $\circ$  \$4,750 per month





## **ARPA Funding**

Assumptions, if:

 $\odot$  There is no additional funding from OHCS for FY2025

Winter 2024-25 City funds for the Lighthouse and Stepping Stone will be depleted

Assumptions, if: OHCS continues to support as they did in FY 2024
All City-supported shelters will continue operating

December 2025 City funds will be completely depleted
