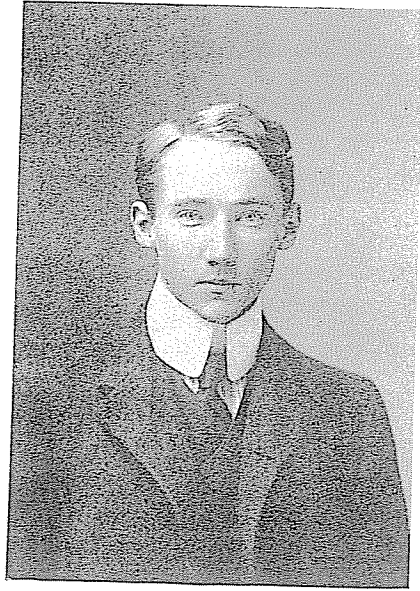

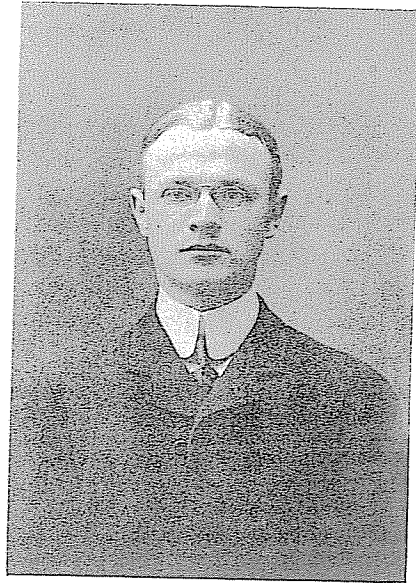


EDWARD S. GOLDTHWAIT.

"Stu" has been concerned with many phases of college life, but eminently as a business man. Junior year he was assistant manager of the Musical Association and manager of the *Gul.*, and this year he is manager of the track team, president of the N. E. I. A. A., and vice-president of the Intercollegiate Amateur Athletic Association. He has also been a member of the Banjo and Mandolin clubs

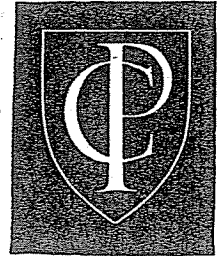

A. L. Goodwillie Is Dead At 67 ¹⁹⁶¹

Was Financier And Housing Authority

Arthur L. Goodwillie, 67, of "Roslyn," Albemarle County, retired financier and one of the country's foremost authorities on the rehabilitation of urban slum areas, died early this morning at the University of Virginia Hospital following a long illness.

The funeral will be held from the residence at noon Thursday, the service to be conducted by his son-in-law, the Rev. Roger Blanchard. Interment will follow at 2:30 o'clock in Spring Hill Cemetery, Lynchburg.

He was born in Chicago November 15, 1878, son of the late James Gunn Goodwillie and Stella Johnson Goodwillie. In 1834 his grandfather, David Goodwillie, came from Scotland to this country and located in Chicago, where the family grew up and his sons took prominent places in the business life of that city.

Mr. Goodwillie graduated from Williams College in 1901, and was a member of Zeta Psi fraternity.

Founded Oregon Town

He was one of this country's foremost authorities on rehabilitation of run-down urban areas. In the early part of the century he founded Bend, Ore., a town which numbered more than 10,000 in the last census. He was attracted to the West from his native Chicago by the potentialities of a huge irrigation plan. With a friend, he purchased large tracts of land in the
