To whom it may concern: I live on Summer Shade Dr behind Blakeley Park. My primary concern regarding traffic is the speed and amount on Brookswood. It is very difficult to turn left onto Brookswood from McClellan. The sign to reduce the speed from 35 mph to 25 mph is ignored and comes too soon and too close to Blakeley Park. Cars drive 40 mph past the park and McClellan. I saw a child almost get hit when he tried to dart across the street and the speeding driver yelled at the child. It's unpleasant to walk to the Old Mill due to cars driving too fast south of the Old Mill on Brookswood. It seems people prefer using Brookswood rather than the highway as they do not need to stop and they cannot access the highway. The non- local traffic on McClellan is also fast and there are no sidewalks. Children in our neighborhood have to walk on the side of the street along with the cars. Please consider reducing the speed on Brookswood to 25 mph at least another 100 meters South of Blakeley Park to give drive a chance to slow down before reaching the park. Please consider speed bumps in front of the park at the crosswalk. Please consider sidewalks (that actually function and are not just checking of a list) for the people of Bend.
