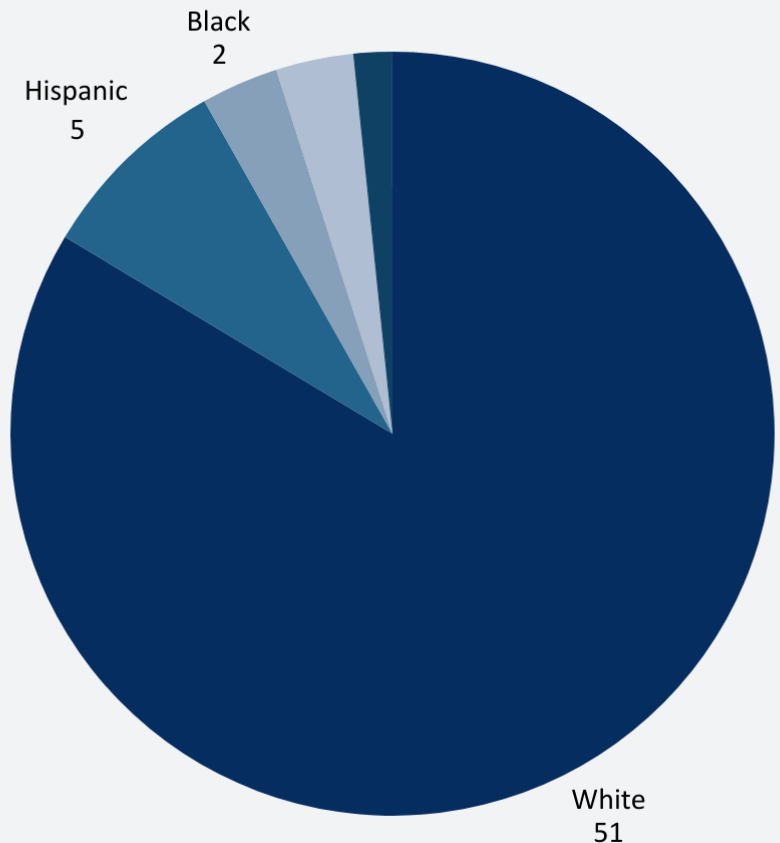
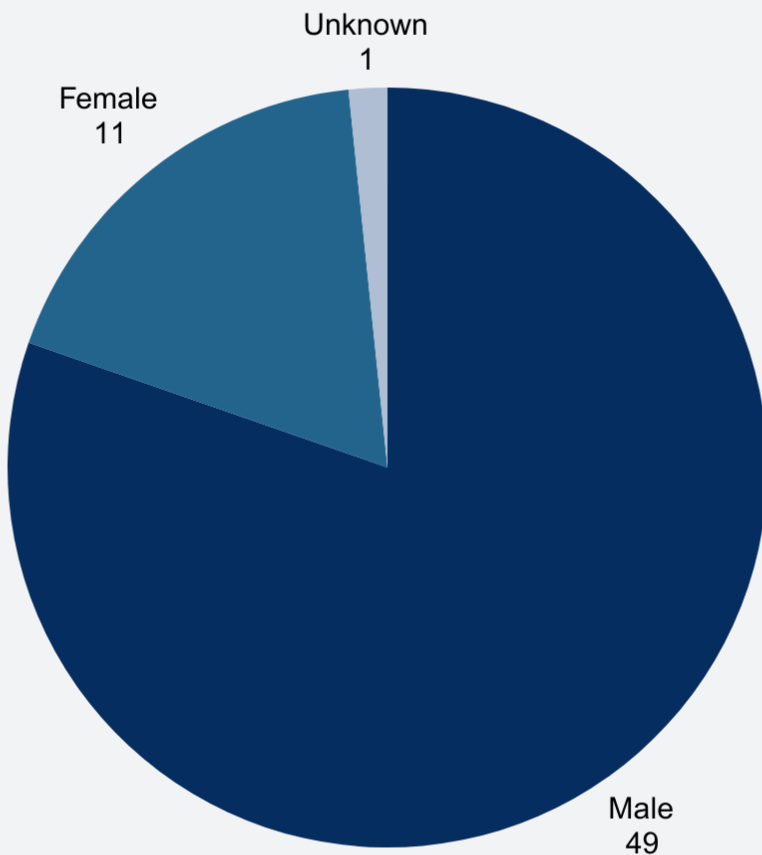
WRAP Restraint use
