

RESOLUTION NO. 3348

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY NO. CP007 TO AFFIRM
THE CITY'S COMMITMENT TO NONDISCRIMINATION IN THE USE OF
DISCRETIONARY FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY PROGRAMS, SERVICES, AND
EVENTS**

FINDINGS

A. Council adopted Resolution 3037 on July 20, 2016, creating Policy No. CP007, which established Council policy regarding discretionary funding/sponsorship of programs, services and events by organizations or individuals, as it is in the best interest of the City to facilitate the transparent and equitable expenditure of funds.

B. On May 18, 2022, Council amended Policy No. CP007 to include Welcoming Week and Juneteenth as official City Events.

C. Council now wishes to further amend and revise CP007 to clarify that a purpose of the Policy is to create and maintain an environment free of discrimination.

Based on these findings and the purpose statement in the attached Council Policy, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Policy No. CP007 is amended and revised to affirm the City's commitment to nondiscrimination in the use of discretionary funding for community programs, services, and events.

Adopted by the Bend City Council on November 1, 2023.




