

RESOLUTION NO. 3387

A RESOLUTION TO CERTIFY THE PROVISION OF MUNICIPAL SERVICES BY THE CITY TO QUALIFY FOR RECEIPT OF STATE SHARED REVENUES.

Findings:

A. ORS 221.760 provides as follows:

1. The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455 (Distribution of certain cigarette tax revenues), 366.785 (Definitions for ORS 366.785 to 366.820) to 366.820 (Limit to application of ORS 366.785 to 366.815) and 471.805 (Disposition of moneys) shall disburse such funds in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants, according to the most recent federal decennial census, only if the officer reasonably is satisfied that the city meets the requirements set out in subsection (2) of this section, or if the city provides four or more of the following municipal services:
 - a. Police protection
 - b. Fire protection
 - c. Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
 - d. Sanitary sewers
 - e. Storm sewers
 - f. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
 - g. One or more utility services

B. City of Bend officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760.

Based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Bend certifies that it provides four or more of the municipal services enumerated in ORS 221.760(1):
 - a. Police protection
 - b. Fire protection
 - c. Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
 - d. Sanitary sewers
 - e. Storm sewers
 - f. Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
 - g. Water Utility


