

RESOLUTION NO. 3428

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 3416

Findings

- A. The Bend City Council adopted Resolution No. 3416 establishing a Safe Parking Pod Grant Program (the "Program") authorizing a proposal to award funds for the purchase of Safe Parking pods.
- B. The Program was initially funded in the amount of \$292,500 awarded to the City of Bend by the Coordinated Houseless Response Office (CHRO) and authorized under Subrecipient Agreement EO 23-02 between the City of Bend and Central Oregon Intergovernmental Council. The funds originated from House Bill 5019 (2023).
- C. The City has requested an additional \$193,000 in House Bill 5019 funds from CHRO and now wishes to amend the Program to allow use of these or other additional funds for costs related to preparing the purchased pods for use as shelters.

Now, therefore, based on these findings,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Authorize funds awarded to Grantees under the Program to be used for expenses related to preparing the pods for shelter use.
- 2. Authorize the City Manager to accept additional funds awarded for the purchase of Safe Parking pods and other costs relating to preparing the pods for use as shelter, including House Bill 5019 (2023) funds awarded by the CHRO and other funds awarded for this purpose.
- 3. Authorize the City Manager to adjust the funding totals available to match the funds available for the Program under Subrecipient Agreement EO 23-02 with Central Oregon Intergovernmental Council and other funds awarded for this purpose.
- 4. Authorize the City Manager to amend existing grant agreements with Central Oregon Villages and Mountain View Community Development in any amount, using Program funds, with no further approval from Council.


