
FY 2024/25 Actual vs. Goal Event Attendance



Regionwide Pending Projects: FY 2024/25, Q2


**Total Projects

Investment by Community**









Bend Pending Projects by Industry



- High Technology activity is predominantly “Start” pending projects.




Cumulative “Start” Done Deals Q2 FY 2024/25


New Ventures Started



Jobs Created by New Ventures





Bend Cumulative “Grow” Done Deals FY 2024/25






