Background: A Task Force comprised of a collection of citizens, property and business owners representing the Galveston Corridor and the city of Bend staff has been formed. This *Task Force* has been meeting over the past few months discussing ways to improve the Galveston Avenue corridor, between 14th Street and the Deschutes River. The objective is to create a more desirable place to live, travel, shop and recreate, and also to establish a strategy for implementing future improvements along the corridor. The Task Force has discussed concerns raised by citizens that frequent the corridor and has identified a number of ideas, opportunities and challenges related to fulfilling this goal. We would like to share our information and hear your comments and ideas about this important central Bend arterial street.
