City of Bend, Transportation Engineer Robin Lewis presented “ Bend Transportation Option Program – System Implementation”

- Implement TSP Goals and Objective and create a Capital Improvement project list for Biking and Walking projects
- Trying to capture a large portion of the population that said they would ride if the route met needs and there was a comfort level. Changing system to accommodate.
- Process was developed with working group committee. Came up with a strategic approach based on input.
- Reviewed the three project categories: Structures, Roadway Network Enhancements, and Overlays
- Ms. Lewis explained the methodology and analysis used to identify walk zones: Downtown Area, Old Mill, Mid Town, Wilson, and 27th & Neff
- Currently working with working group committee to set criteria for prioritization of projects. Also, working at the same time with a consulting group in partnership to develop a criteria that would be implemented beyond Bend.

Ms. Lewis will bring back the prioritization list when completed for the IAC to review.
