


Accomplishments: Accessible + Effective Government



- Equity Framework developed and piloted

- Right of Way Code adopted and implemented
- Infrastructure Asset Management used for prioritization and maintenance decisions




Highlights: Affordable Housing + Sustainable Development



- Secured \$5 million PRO Housing grant for affordable housing development and process improvements
- Secured additional shelter funding
- Partnered with Deschutes County on the Temporary Safe Stay Area
- Created a homeless services grant program

- Target Sector Study completed
- Permitting timelines improved
- Completed RFP and sold property in Juniper Ridge

- Created Site Specific TIF for employment




Accomplishments: Environment + Climate

- Water Reclamation Facility Plan in process




Accomplishments: Public Safety





