Hawthorne Station Tour	<p>Background Cascades East Transit (CET) and Central Oregon Intergovernmental Council (COIC) staff worked collaboratively with the Hawthorne Avenue Neighbors coalition and adjacent business and property owners to redesign the parking lot and bus bays at Hawthorne Station, CET's central transit hub. Constructed in 2024 and early 2025, the project created new loading areas in front of and behind Hawthorne Station to improve traffic flow. It also included new bus shelters, pedestrian improvements, and information to make taking the bus easier.
