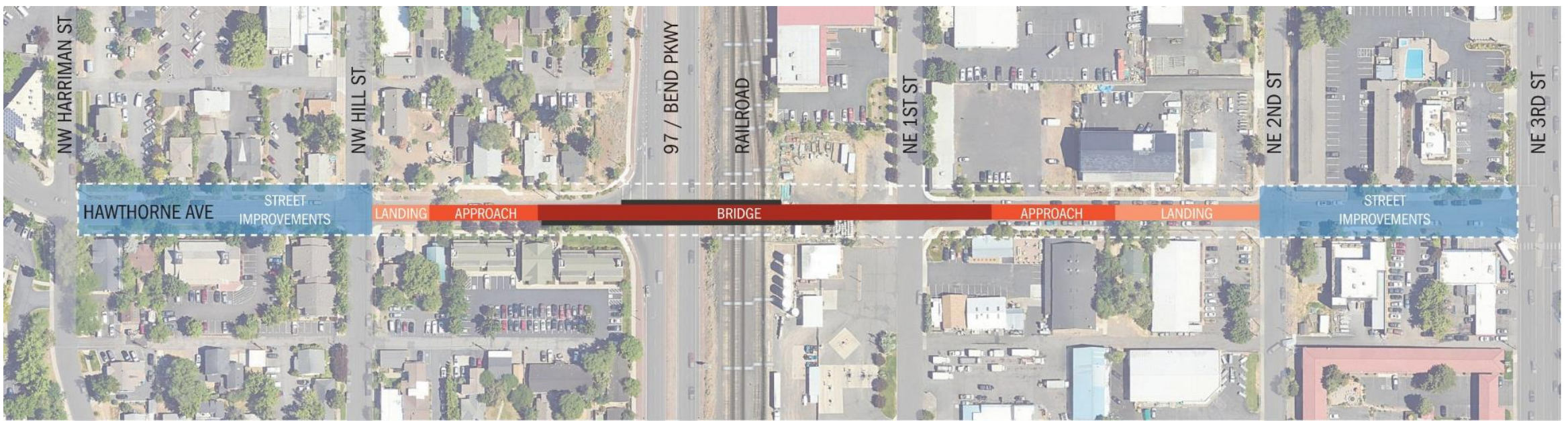

- 33 comment forms

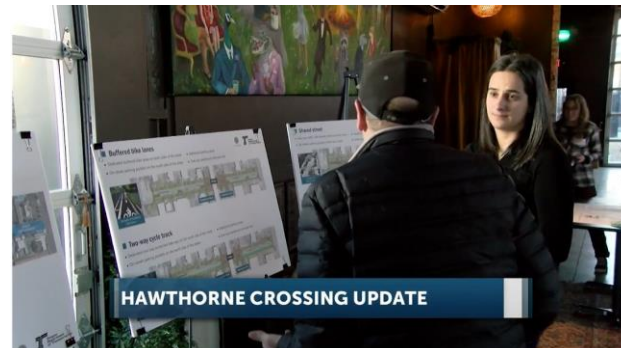
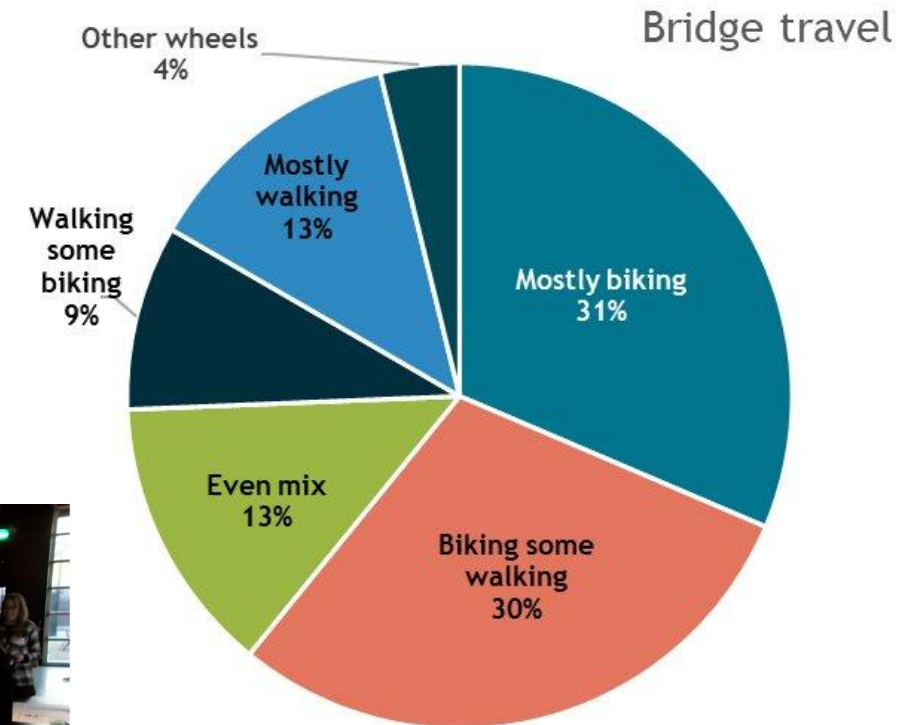
Online Open House

Bridge travel modes (156 responses):

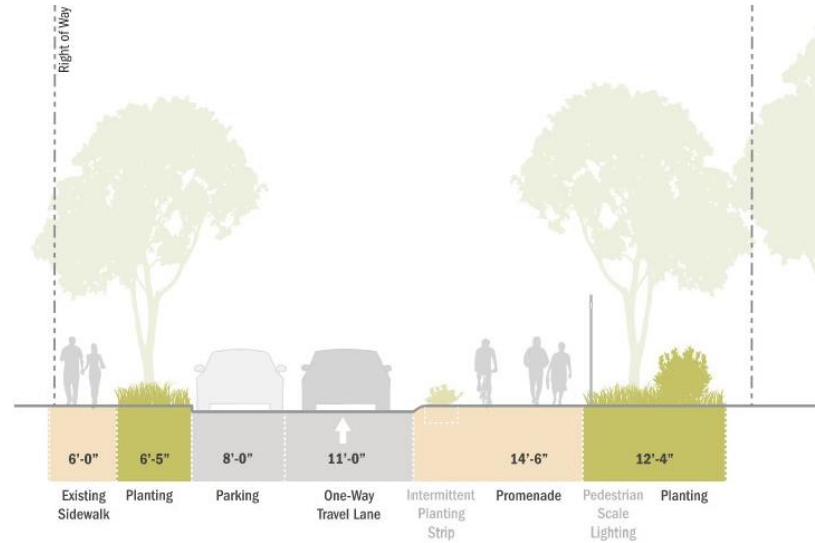
Participants indicated they plan to use the bridge **primarily for biking** (49) or a mix of **biking and some walking** (46), while fewer selected they would use it mainly for **walking** (20).



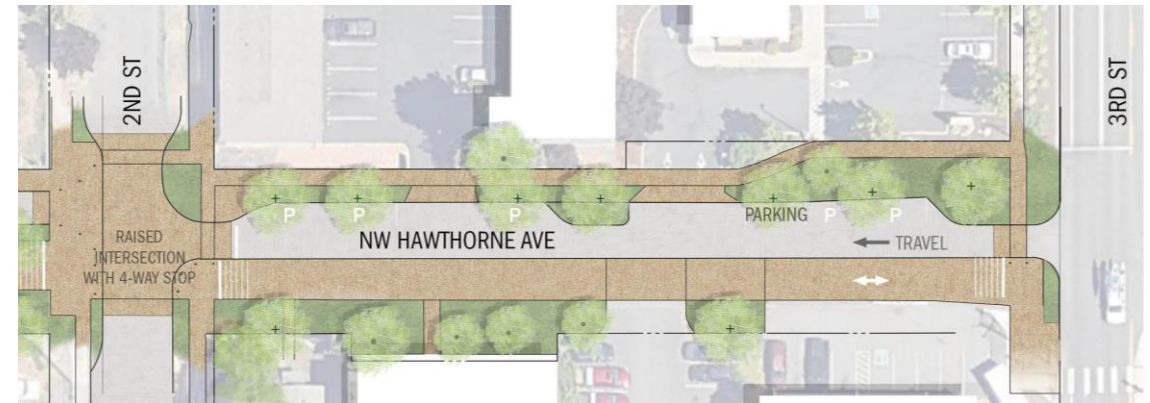
Promenade Street Beyond Hill & 2nd

- Additional planting

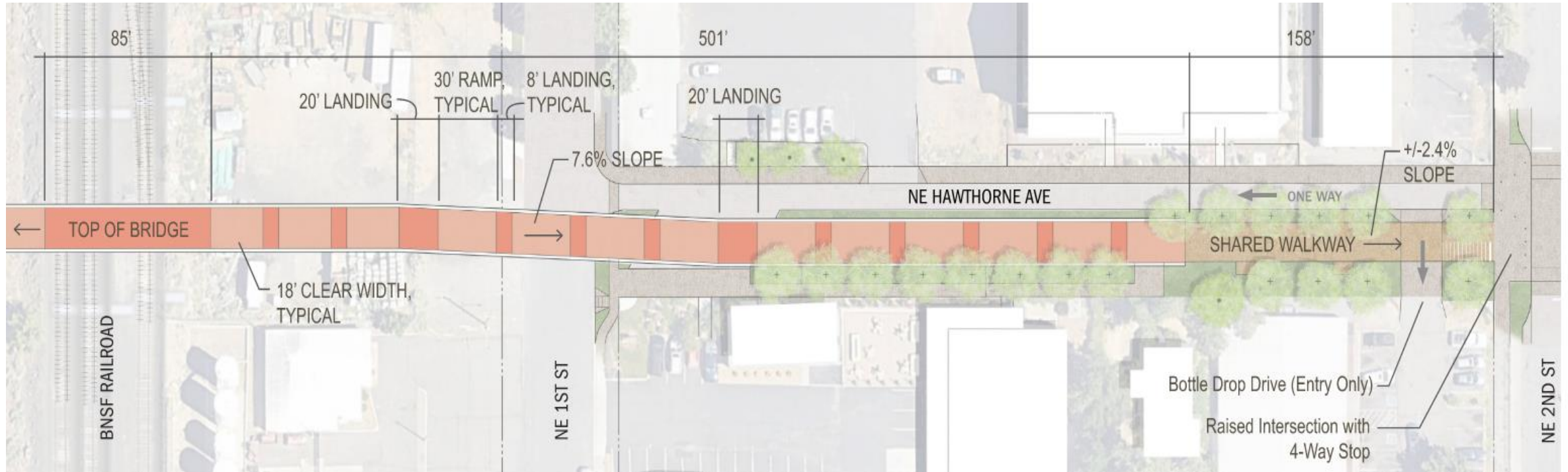


West side Promenade concept (Harriman to Hill)



East side Promenade concept (Second to Third)

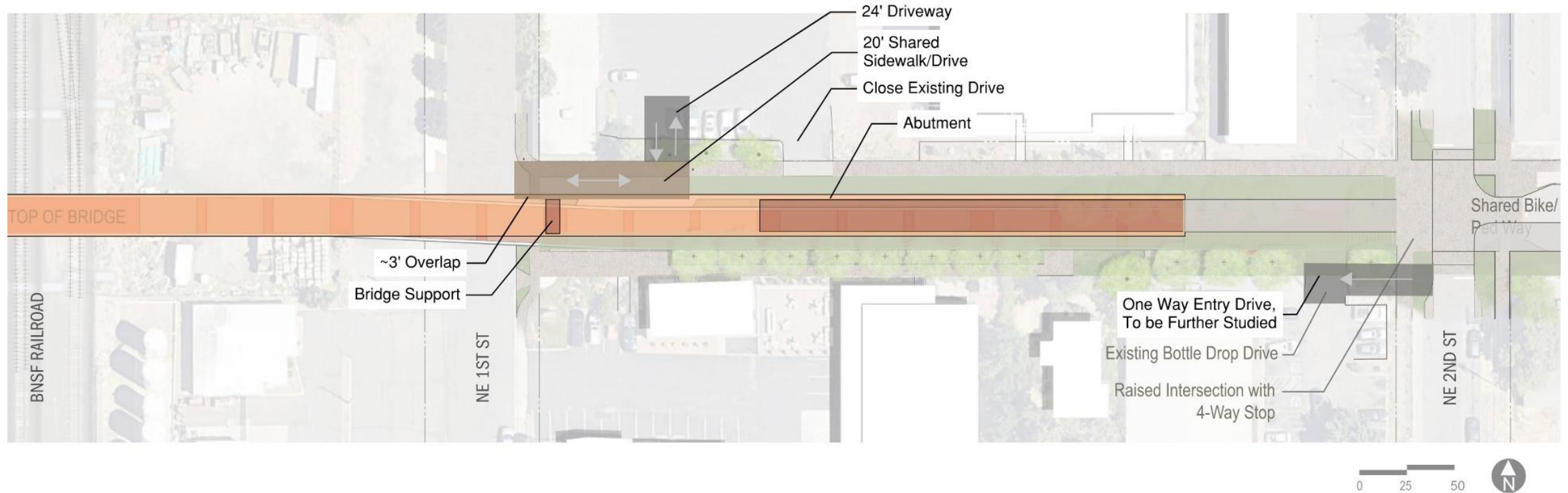

Modified Alignment - Driveway Access

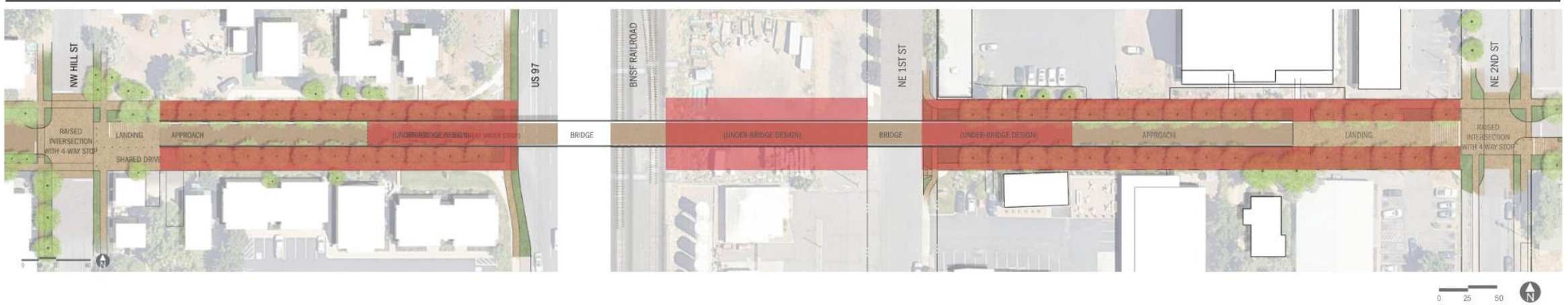


Hawthorne People Street (1st to 2nd)
