

SAFE PARKING – INTERESTED PARTIES CHECKLIST

Thank you for your interest in Safe Parking. We are excited to begin working with you to provide solutions for community members experiencing houselessness.

In the City of Bend, there are two types of Safe Parking, Overnight Parking and Transitional Overnight Parking Accommodation.

Overnight Camping Checklist:

Check all that are true

- ☐ The location is owned or leased by a business, non-profit, or religious or public entity.
- ☐ The location is paved or has gravel.
- ☐ The program is prepared to provide sanitation services, including a toilet, hand washing, and trash disposal facilities.
- ☐ The program will not require payment of any fee, rent, or other monetary charge for overnight camping.

If the site checks all the boxes above, you are ready to begin operating. Although City of Bend authorization is not required for this type of location, we look forward to partnering with you!
